The SC1 balloting draft of PC95.3.1 (Draft Recommended Practice for Measurements and Computations of Human Exposure to Electric and Magnetic Fields, 0 Hz to 100 kHz C95.3.1) was completed on January 9, 2009

On Jan 12, the draft standard was sent to SC1 for balloting; balloting closed on Jan 30 with the following results:

On February 5, 2009 SC1 held a meeting at the FDA headquarters in White Oak Maryland to review and prepare responses to the comments and address other issues raised. During and after this meeting the draft standard was extensively edited and prepared for an SC1 recirculation ballot. The recirculation ballot will take place in June.

Once the recirculation ballot is completed, the draft will be submitted to the IEEE Standards Department for Sponsor Ballot. The Invitation to Ballot sent earlier resulted in more than 70 persons joining the Ballot Group.
