5. Old Business:

Discussion of final revision of C95.7 Recommended Practice for RF Safety Programs and next steps

Discussion of recent regulatory activity by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) as it relates to IEEE C95.7:

- (1) FCC Report and Order (R&O)-(2) Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPR) and (3) Notice of Inquiry (NOI)

RC discussed the FCC Publication:

- Deadline for comments for FNPR and NOI September 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Petition for reconsideration for R&O possible before July 5
- For compliance: Supplement C to be replaced by the knowledge database
- Definitions for “fully aware”
- 1 mW exclusion vs IEC report 62479 published 2010 (working group 5 on low power exclusion) 1.6 W or 2.0 W and ICNIP 20 mW
- Exemption (except cell phone) for full evaluation based on Frequency Power and Distance for all devices

6. New Business:

What should SC-2 do in C95.7 to address Table 3 regarding electro explosive devices and flammable atmosphere? Ray Harmon states that all exposure categories should have mandated (\*) evaluation as the limits can be as low that 0.5 V/m at 20-80 MHz. In addition a new line item for flammable exposure (will be different for different flammable materials) should be evaluated for which exposure category it should be evaluated.

What should SC-2 do in regard to expanding C95.7 to address “low frequencies”? Consensus is that there are too many differences and thus should be treated in a separate document.

What would be best format for a separate collection of example applications of the revised C95.7?

Addendum would be the best option for doing this.
